Targeted hectares: Total potential fields in the CDM is about 298 183 ha. It is assumed that Agri-Park could potentially target an average of 10 436ha (2 - 5%) of the available potential fields. Job Creation: the CDM Agri-Park has the potential to create about 8400¹ direct and indirect jobs, over the next 10 years. Smallholder Farmers: It is assumed that the CDM Agri-Park has the potential of introducing up to 3 330 additional smallholder farmers based on an estimate of about 10 436ha production increase.
