11. The quantity or volume of the LMO to be exported from South Africa?
12. A complete list of the varieties/hybrids of the LMO.
13. Requirements for safe handling, storage, transport and use, including packaging, labelling, documentation, disposal and contingency procedures, where appropriate.
14. Methods and plans used in South Africa for monitoring of the LMO
15. Emergency procedures that will be applied in South Africa in the event of an accident with the LMO

16. An evaluation of the foreseeable impacts, in particular any pathogenic and ecologically disruptive impacts of the LMO's.
17. A import permit/letter of authority permitting import by Competent National Authority or government department engaged with issuance of import permits for LMOs within the Party of Import

- The correct fee must accompany the application form.
- The potential exporter is responsible for obtaining the consent from the Party of Import for the proposed transboundary movement.
- An import permit from the National Competent Authority OR letter of authority from the responsible party indicating permission for import of events specified in application form. *Any import permit or letter issued in a foreign language should be accompanied by a certified copy of the officially translated letter or permit.*
- Please take note that although a notification as required by Article 8 of the CPB is not required for LMO's intended for contained use or FFP; the Party of Import may require such a notification, and any other procedures, within its domestic regulatory frameworks.
- Considering the statement made in the previous paragraph, the Registrar's office will issue a permit for exportation of LMO's intended for contained use or FFP if the application is in compliance with the prescribed requirements.
- A Party is a Party in terms of the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety.
- These procedures are also applicable for exports to non-Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety.
